Subject: Community guide to good practices for the European Guide to good practices for the industrial manufacture of safe feed materials

In accordance with the outcome of the assessment carried out at the meeting of 20-21 November 2014, the PAFF (Plant, Animal, Feed and Food) Committee on Animal Nutrition discussed the final version 3.1 of the "**European Guide to good practices for the industrial manufacture of safe feed materials**" pursuant to Article 22 of Regulation (EC) No 183/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 January 2005 laying down requirements for feed hygiene.

After having examined the last version introduced by EFISC, including the comments submitted by Member States in several restricted working groups, the PAFF Committee, agreed to the publication of the EU guide to good practices including 3 specific sector reference documents (biodiesel processing - Version 1.1; starch processing - Version 3.1; oilseed crushing and vegetable oil refining - Version 3.1); EU Salmonella check list and the Factsheet on Salmonella as well.

This European Guide and its sector reference documents will be published with its title and references in the C series of the Official Journal of the European Union and in SANTE web page with the title:


